

## FINANCE REPORT

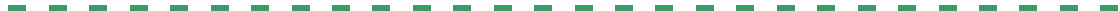
We have made some progress on pledges however we are \$22,138 down on our total budget as of Oct. 31, 2011.



# JANUARY CHILDRENS' NEWSLETTER



The Children's Department had a very successful 2011. The Sunday School Program averages about 30 children a week, with many committed volunteer teachers. We continue to have an active number of participants in the Parents Night Out program, choir, chimes, weekend retreats and the 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Momentum. The Momentum encouraged children to worship God with Presbyterian and Lutheran Green Mountain Churches. We had about 7 different families take part in the Father's Day Out at the Park. Our Vacation Bible School was a free program this year, "Shake it Up" helped children understand how to believe in God. We had about 60 children involved. The children raised about \$300 dollars for the Heifer Project, donated many combs, tooth brushes/paste, soaps and wash clothes to the Pregnant Teens during VBS and will help the Action Center collect food. We had a very fun, "The Grumpy Shepherds" program for the Children's Christmas Program. The 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade girls went on a mountain retreat in the mountains.
